Four tryptychs for four bus shelters near the Las Vegas Convention Center on Paradise Road in Las Vegas, Nevada

Commissioned by the the Southern Nevada Transportation Commission.  
\$75,000 project budget.

Each 8' x 5' image is made of a 1/2" resin material consisting of four 2' wide sections. The panels are the translucent back walls of each bus shelters. The design consists of a front layer of half tones based on images found in the Las Vegas Visitors and Convention Authority's archive. The images were shot during by LVCVA photographers during the location shooting for the film "Diamonds are Forever" in 1971. The images selected were shot in very close proximity to the location of the bus shelters. The back layer of the design is based on the artists' photographs of decorative mid-century block walls in adjacent residential neighborhoods.
